- Opening with the harmony of Conty : La Fraternelle 3min
- Carriages (arriving from Amiens and Grandvilliers) : parade, public salutations, exit 4 min
- Drums arrive 2 min
- The first drum calls the goose trainer 1 min
- Goose trainer, the gaggle pass between the drums and the trainer calls the dancers from Crèvecœur 3 min
- Second drum calls Aude Muller and her free horse 3 min
- 3rd drum :
  - evocation of AVS (one large carriage and small carriages)
  - number of Fanny and Pauline (horsewomen AVS) with two Spanish horses2 min 30
- 4th drum calls the nations
- Parade of nations, with the music of the harmony La Fraternelle : the carriages stand in the main arena, in front of the tribunes
- The chefs d'équipes take their flag on the carriage and the others are behind them on foot

- The 4 drums play together, 20 adults AVS + 1 child CCAS + 1 child Les Enfants de la Lune run the flags up.
- One adult AVS runs the FEI flag up.
